# Diamond Princess into quarantine

**THE** coronavirus crisis has seen Princess Cruises' *Diamond Princess* placed into quarantine off the coast of Yokohama, Japan after a previous passenger was diagnosed with the disease.

More than 3,600 people are aboard the ship, all of whom are undergoing formal medical checks conducted by the Japanese Ministry of Health.

Princess said the turnaround of *Diamond Princess* would be delayed for about 24 hours while officials review the health status of all guests and crew.

"On the previous voyage, a guest from Hong Kong embarked in Yokohama on 20 Jan, sailed one segment of the itinerary, and then disembarked in Hong Kong on 25 Jan.

"He visited a local Hong Kong hospital six days after leaving the ship, where he later tested positive for coronavirus on 01



Feb," the company said.

Princess said that while aboard the ship, the man did not visit the vessel's medical centre to report any symptoms or illness, and the 80-year-old patient is reported to be in a stable condition while family members travelling with him remain symptom-free.

"The safety, security and well-being of all guests and crew is our absolute priority," the cruise line added, noting that the review of arriving guests and crew by

Japanese health authorities is standard practice.

Unfortunately the following *Diamond Princess* voyage, M004, has been cancelled, with all guests to receive a full refund as well as a 100% future cruise credit.

**SILVERSEA** Cruises has confirmed the revision of three Asian itineraries in response to the coronavirus outbreak.



"Our ships are truly pristine and healthy, and we already have measurable results to prove it from our initial pilot program on one ship.

"We reduced guest reported illness by 50%, eliminated over 1,000 plastic bottles of cleaning products, and dramatically reduced water usage by 1.1

million gallons per year," he added.

The news follows Lindblad's transition to become a carbon neutral company during 2019, offsetting 100% of its ships' emissions, all land-based operations, staff travel, and for its offices in New York and Seattle.

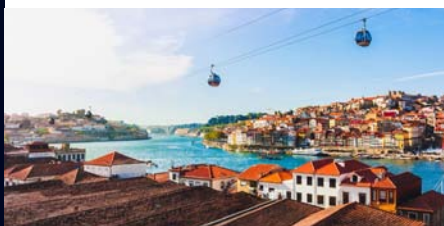
